

MOON CACTUS

Planting: Moon Cacti perform best in small, shallow containers. Always choose containers with drainage holes, and plant in a coarse, well-drained soil mix formulated for cacti and succulents. Position each plant so that it stands upright in the pot and its roots are fully covered with soil.

Light/Temperature: Moon Cacti thrive in bright, indirect light and work well in nearly any room in the home. If you choose to enjoy your plants outdoors during the summer months, place them in a location that is protected from direct sunlight. Move the plants indoors before the temperature drops below 50°F in fall.

Watering: Water Moon Cacti thoroughly so that the soil is fully saturated and water drains from the holes at the bottom of the pot. Allow the soil to dry out almost completely between waterings. Discontinue watering during winter to allow the plants to go dormant, then resume a regular watering schedule in spring.

Feeding: Feed your plants with a small amount of cactus fertilizer once per month during the growing season. Do not fertilize during the winter months.
